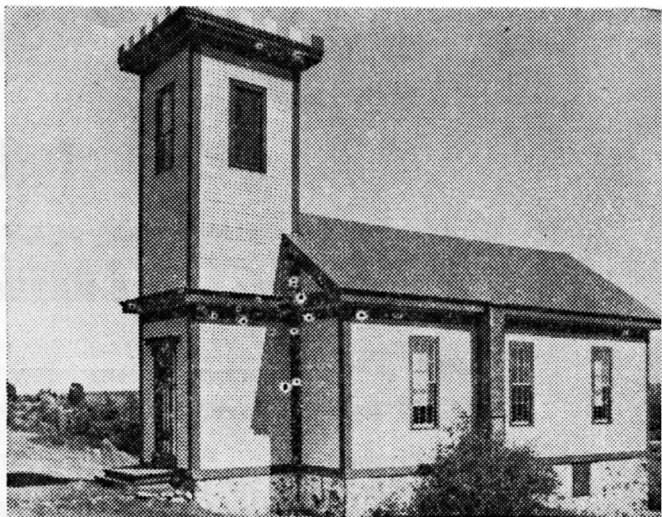

Announcements

The Executive Committee is honored to have Dr. Winfield S. Haycock, Senior Pastor of Christ United Methodist Church, Rochester, Minnesota, in charge of the Reunion Service this year.

Central Mine Methodist Church thanks the Community Church of Calumet for the gift of hymnals, which eliminates the need for the words to hymns and the responsive reading to be printed in the program for the first time since the services begun in 1907.

During the years when the Central Mine operated, it was recognized that the community was so heavily populated by "Cousin Jacks" that a newly arrived miner coming to Central to work could find no area where he could feel more at home, and it was reported that when his family in Cornwall learned that he was working at "The Central" they derived a certain comfort from the news. Attention of Cornishmen was focused upon Central this year for the first time in this century, when Harry Tregilgas came to the Copper Country last fall to see the region to which so many of his countrymen had emigrated many years ago. He was guided during his visit by John Rowe, Jr. who, in the course of their tour, visited Central. He was intrigued by the spirit that has kept the Central Reunion alive and wrote of his visit and of Central to his newspaper when he returned to Cornwall. The Reverend R. Hubert Luke, Chairman, The Methodist Church, Cornwall District, became interested and contacted Mr. Rowe, to whom he ultimately sent a taped greeting which has been included in the program this morning. While his greeting is to the Cornishmen in Michigan, it was spoken with a special direction to Central, we are told.

Still another communication from Cornwall, probably the result of the same newspaper article, is from Mr. R. T. Williams of Mousehole, Penzance. He concludes a very interesting letter with these words: "This won't reach you in time for your Reunion and service, but I wish and hope it goes off well

The baptism during this morning's service of Ginette Alicia Ruckel, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Raymond W. Ruckels follows by 27 years the baptism of her mother in this same church. Ginette's great-grandfather is Dr. Frederick W. Bryant, Sr., himself a native of Central and a communicant in this church when he was a child. At present he serves as the chairman of the Executive Committee.
